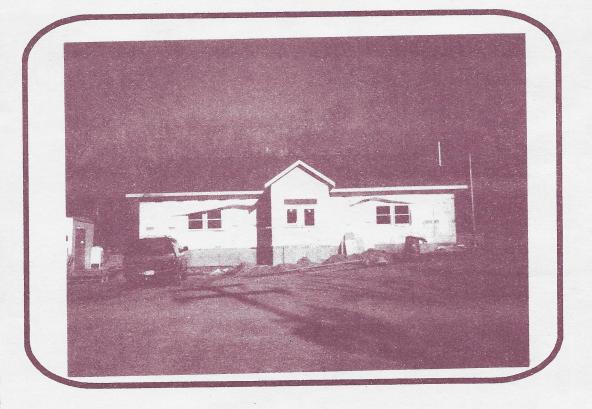

Dear Florida Public Library Resident,

This brochure will provide you with the needed information to make an informed decision on the proposed \$146,160.00 Library Budget. This budget will be presented to the voters on Tuesday, May 16, 2000. Library Trustees will also be elected at that time.

The Village of Florida is constructing a building which the Village Trustees have designated for use as a library. The Library and the Village are entering into a long term rental agreement. It is anticipated that the Library will be able to occupy the new building in the late spring/early summer, 2000.

The Village of Florida Trustees have worked diligently with the Library Trustees toward the establishment of a permanent home for the Library in recognition of the needs and desires of the entire Florida school district community.

People within the community have donated generously and the Friends of the Florida Public Library have fund raised intensively for the last five years towards this goal. A Library Building fund was established in the 1980s. Many people in the community have purchased "Bricks" as part of the Build Your Library campaign started by the Library Trustees. The "Brick" donations have been added to the Library Building fund making it possible for the Library to make a contribution towards the building construction costs. Memorial funds have also been established in memory of loved ones to benefit the Library.

These funds have not only benefitted the project by contributing directly to construction costs but also to the hidden costs of providing necessary furniture, shelving and additional library materials. However, all expenses have not been covered and the costs associated with providing expanded services and hours are presented in the proposed budget. Donations are still being gratefully accepted.

Tax Payment Example

The following tables provide examples of the estimated tax increase for the proposed 2000/2001 Florida Public Library Budget. The examples are based on the average assessed value tax rate increase per one thousand dollars of assessed value.

Town of Goshen

If you live in the Town of Goshen, the assessed value of your home is also the full value. The projected average assessed value tax increase per one thousand dollars of assessed value is sixteen cents. The tax rate for the 1999 budget was thirty-five cents per one thousand dollars of assessed value.

Town of Warwick

If you live in the Town of Warwick, your assessed value is a fraction of the full value of your home. The projected average assessed value tax increase per one thousand dollars of assessed value is seventy-one cents. The tax rate for the 1999 budget was one dollar thirty-eight cents per one thousand dollars of assessed value.
