All qualified voters of the school district are eligible to vote and absentee ballot applications are available now. Our proposed budget is on page 2 and copies are available in the library. In addition to approval of our yearly funding, voters will elect two trustees for three-year terms.

In May, we adopted a Long Range Plan to guide our programs and services for the next five years. Notably, residents from all sectors of the community called on the Board to expand library space. We take your concerns seriously and are working on it! As we address our space issue, discuss and plan what FPL should look like and do, please add your ideas to the mix. We want to hear from you. As always we encourage you to vote.
