From Your Board

A Message

FPL's annual budget vote and trustee election has been affected by the Covid-19 health emergency and quarantine, the same as every other facet of life as we knew it. Our original vote, scheduled for April, had to be postponed due to our closure. We had been waiting for some news from Governor Cuomo on how to proceed. Now that clear guidance has emerged, we can see a way forward to provide our annual election for voters, but with some changes.

Following the recommendation of the Ramapo Catskill Library System to seek efficiency with library votes, we will partner with the Florida Union Free School District and hold our budget vote & trustee election on the same ballot on June 9, 2020. Per the Governor's order, all voting will be by absentee ballot and each registered voter in the FUFSD will receive a ballot in the mail to be mailed back in a postage paid envelope by 5 p.m. on June 9.

Our proposed budget is here and also on our website in more detail. In addition to approval of our yearly funding, voters will elect two trustees for full three-year terms. Incumbents Nancy B. Scott and Kevin Lundell will be on the ballot. Profiles of the candidates will be on our website and in local newspapers.

Over the last few months, we have been developing a new strategic plan for the next five years. While recent events may have altered the way in which we will provide services and programs, we are still the same hometown library you have always known. We appreciate your strong and ongoing support and count on seeing you soon.

Located at Roe Brothers, Inc. at 65 Maple Avenue in the village, FPL's Little Free Library is helping to minimize the pain that readers of all ages are feeling now that we are closed due to the Covid-19 coronavirus.
