

Patron Guidelines for Library Reopening to the Public

Limited Hours & Occupancy

The library will be open to the public:
Monday – Thursday: 10- a.m. – 7 p.m.
Friday & Saturday: 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Curbside Service Hours

Monday – Thursday: 11 a.m. – 7 p.m.
Friday & Saturday: 11 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Limited to 10 patrons at a time.

Patrons may browse all collections however we ask that their visit be quick and efficient.

All children (ages 10 and under) must be accompanied by an adult.

The front doors will continue to be locked. Patrons will be requested to enter through the rear door off the deck. The handicapped door is open should access be required. Patrons will exit through the handicapped door.

Upon Entering:

Patrons must wear a mask. If they don't have one, we can provide one.

Hand sanitizer and gloves will be available for patrons at tables by doors.

Patrons must maintain at least 6 feet of distance from others and follow all directional signs.

Services Available:

Computer usage will be by appointment or as a walk-in.

There will be no public seating. The tables in the reference area and children's room are not available.

Patrons will not be able to use the water fountains.

Curbside service will continue. Patrons will be encouraged to use curbside services if they just need to pick up items.

The outside book drop will remain open and all items must be returned in the outside bin.

Contactless Check Out:

Patrons are asked to place their card on the counter for scanning.

Patrons should open books or DVD cases for staff to scan barcode.

Browsing:

New Releases

Chairs are not available to patrons.

Only one patron at a time.

Please follow all directional signs.

Stacks

Only one patron in each aisle at a time.

Please follow all directional signs.

Children's Room

Limit 4 patrons at a time.

No seating at tables.

Children (ages 10 and under) must be accompanied by an adult.
